State University Internship Incentive Program

MCLA offers university-sponsored internship grants through the Massachusetts State University Internship Incentive Program and the MCLA Foundation.

Funding is available on a limited basis for students who meet the requirements.

REQUIREMENTS:

- ♦ Massachusetts State Resident
- ◆ Full Time Matriculated Student (during the academic year)
- ♦ Minimum 2.75 Overall GPA
- ♦ Completed FAFSA Application
- ♦ Unmet financial need
- ♦ Not a prior Internship Incentive Grant Recipient

The Grant may cover tuition, fees, travel and additional expenses associated with a student's approved internship. The amount of the award is prorated based on the number of internship credits applied for. Grants range from \$650 to \$5,000.

Qualified applicants of the Internship Incentive Grant Program will receive notification of their award from the Financial Aid Office. Eligibility is automatically reviewed based on the Internship Application.

Once awarded, the funds will be applied toward any outstanding tuition and fee balance the student may have for the internship. Any excess funding after paying for the internship credits, may be refunded to the student to cover additional expenses. In some cases, to prevent an over-award, student loans may have to be reduced.

Students may only receive the grant one time during their enrollment at MCLA
